Host Specials | Audience Attendant Side Program

Go Short has an extensive side programme. As an audience attendant, you will ensure that our side programme runs smoothly. This means that you can explain what's happening in our exposition space, help set up a special event, hand out VR glasses or check tickets for film screenings in a container.

This year, we have an exhibition space where visitors can view an exhibition and enjoy VR experiences. In the exhibition space, you will welcome visitors, have a chat with them and ensure that the VR glasses work. It is useful if you are familiar with technology for this function.

- Flexible and independent
- A bit technical

Working hours: during the festival, between 10:00 and 23:00

Room Manager

As a Room Manager you are the host of one of the film rooms in LUX and you oversee this room. You check the tickets at the entrance, make sure everything is set up for the screening and are the first point of contact for guests in the room. During the film, you keep an eye on the progress of the program in collaboration with the projectionist and location manager and ensure a pleasant film experience in the hall. You will keep an eye on things such as whether the sound is not too loud and whether it is not too hot or cold in the hall. After the screening you prepare the room for the next program. In this function you learn to work together with people in different functions. You gain experience in quality and experience management; you ensure that guests have the best possible experience during the screenings.

You:

- Are assertive and able to multitask
- Like to take responsibility
- Can communicate with different people (location managers and projectionist)
- Are punctual and clear in your communication
- Are familiar with using a walkie-talkie (not mandatory, but it's an advantage)

Working hours: Before and during the festival, between 09:00 and 00:00.

Distribution team

In the weeks before the festival, the distribution team makes sure that Go Short is visible for everyone in Nijmegen. We promote the festival by spreading flyers and posters all over the city centre. We are looking for heroes who want to help spread promotion materials by walking distribution routes through Nijmegen before festival. If you like to work together, we will try to connect you to another volunteer from the distribution team.

As a volunteer at the distribution team spread flyers and posters through Nijmegen. You try to make sure every café or restaurant accepts your poster and flyers!
