European Competition Jury



Norika Sefa

Norika Sefa is a filmmaker from Kosovo. She is best known for her 2021 debut film Looking for Venera, which established her as an emerging talent with a distinguished voice. The film won and was nominated for many prestigious awards. Norika is writer/director. who has also produced and edited her own work. Her earlier works include Desde Arriba. a short documentary filmed in the Peruvian jungle under the guidance of Werner Herzog. Her most recent short. Like a Sick Yellow is an avant-garde documentary that further explores her bold approach to storytelling and visual expression. Invitations brought Norika across different arts and cultural institutions. to talk about her distinctive cinematic approach and especially working in the small film industry, such as in Kosovo, Norika is a member of the European Film Academy.



Rubén Corral

Rubén Corral is a film curator and the Head of Programming at ZINEBI – International Festival of Documentary and Short Film of Bilbao. He has curated film series on Basque contemporary cinema for the International Short Film Festival Oberhausen (Germany), Indiana University Cinema (USA), Festival de Cinéma de la Ville de Québec (Canada), Filmoteca de Navarra (Spain) and Azkuna Center's Cinematheque (Spain). For ZINEBI he also curated retrospectives devoted to the short films of Apichatpong Weerasethakul, Wang Bing, Marco Bellocchio or Aki Kaurismäki, among others. He is a member of the European Film Academy and holds an MA in Multimedia Journalism, as well as a DAS in History of Spanish Cinema. He has been co-director of ZINEBI Networking and professor at the Basque Country Film School (ECPV).



Hoda Taheri

Hoda Taheri is an Iranian filmmaker and artist based in Berlin. She earned her bachelor's degree in Visual Communication in Malaysia before moving to Germany in 2018 as a political refugee. There, she studied film directing at the German Film and Television Academy Berlin (DFFB). Her Mother Trilogy – Mother Prays All Day Long, As If Mother Cried That Night, and Mother Is a Natural Sinner – premiered at the Locarno Film Festival over three consecutive years and was later screened at numerous other festivals. She has been nominated twice for the German Short Film Award. Hoda is currently developing her debut feature, I'll Plant My Hands in the Garden.



Yassin Karmoudi

Yassin Karmoudi, from Roosendaal, built a career in the film industry. With experience as an (impact) producer and storyteller in The Netherlands and Belgium. As Talent Coordinator or Documentary and Fiction at NPO, he oversees programs that support emerging filmmakers. He is also a co-founder of the New Producers Academy (NPA), an award-winning initiative that trains and mentors diverse producers. Through NPO and NPA, Yassin is dedicated to fostering new talent, increasing industry accessibility, and promoting inclusivity in audiovisual storytelling.

Theo Panagopoulos

Theo Panagopoulos is a Greek-Lebanese-Palestinian filmmaker and researcher based in Scotland. His work explores themes of collective memory, displacement, fragmented identities and archives. He has directed multiple short films that screened in reputable festivals and his most recent film called *The Flowers Stand Silently, Witnessing* has won the best short film award at IDFA 2024, Best Short Film Grand Jury Prize at Sundance 2025 and was nominated for a BAFTA. He is currently completing his PhD research on colonial film archives connected to 1930s Palestine.



Anna Demianenko

Anna Demianenko is the Head of Talent and Programs at CineSud, where she organizes various events, labs and programs for talent development. In addition to her work at CineSud, she has directed four short films that explore diverse narratives. Her latest short film *ROUNDS*, is set to screen at Roze Filmdagen 2025. Currently, her short film *At Home* with Family Affair Films is in preproduction, and she is developing her first feature.

The Go Short Awards

European Competition

A total of 42 international films are selected in the fiction, documentary and animation categories. The films presented in these three categories compete for their respective awards. These awards are jury prizes and carry a monetary prize granted by Go Short and one free DCP mastering service, courtesy of our partner Green DCP. Go Short is recognized as a Qualifying Festival for the Academy Awards[®]. Each award also serves as an Oscar qualifier.

Best International Short Fiction Film

€ 1.500,– + Green DCP mastering, qualifies for the Academy Awards[®].

Best International Short Documentary

€ 1.500,– + Green DCP mastering, qualifies for the Academy Awards[®].

Best International Short Animation

€ 1.500,– + Green DCP mastering, qualifies for the Academy Awards[®].

New Arrivals Competition

The New Arrivals award for the best European student film is a jury prize and carries a cash prize of \pounds 1.500,–.

Go Short is recognized as Qualifying Festival by the Student Academy Awards[®] (SAA). All films selected for the New Arrivals Competition are eligible for the SAA if they have also been selected for competition in at least two other SAA- recognized festivals.

Dutch Competition

Go Short / VEVAM Award for Best Dutch Film The award is a jury prize and carries € 5.000,– in cash, courtesy of VEVAM. VEVAM is the Dutch directors rights organization. The winner also qualifies for the Academy Awards[®].

Go Short Audience Award

The most popular film out of the European, Dutch and New Arrivals Competition as voted by the Go Short audience. The award carries a cash prize of \notin 750,–.

Qualification European Film Awards[®]

Out of the European, New Arrivals and the Dutch Competition the juries will nominate one film that qualifies for the longlist of the European Film Awards. The winner of the European Film Award for Best Short Film 2025 will be announced in December.

Go Short Youth Award

The award is a jury prize determined by the Go Short Youth Jury and carries ${\bf \in 500,-.}$

Go Short Senior Award

The Award is a jury prize determined by the Go Short Senior Jury and carries €500,-

Nomination European Audience Award

The highest scoring Dutch short film eligible for the Go Short Audience Award automatically qualifies for the European Short Film Audience Award (ESFAA).

Best Music Video Award

The best music video in our Music Video competition. The award is a jury prize and carries € 500,–.

European Competition

The selection for the European competition consists of 42 films made by makers from all over Europe. The highly rated films are eligible for Best European Short in the fiction, documentary and animation categories. The films of the European Competition are divided into a number of film blocks, put together based on overlapping themes. The winner in the fiction, documentary and animation categories will qualify for the Oscars.






